Why merging HLS and HUG?


- Single source

 - Working towards one commonly agreed roadmap
- Optimise standards development process
 - GS1 Healthcare Work Teams define use cases and business requirements
 - Fed into the GSMP and EPCglobal processes



What is GS1 Healthcare?

GS1 Healthcare is a voluntary, global user community bringing together all healthcare stakeholders

- Pharmaceutical and medical devices manufacturer
- Wholesalers and distributors, group purchasing organisations
- Hospitals and pharmacy retailers
- Logistics providers
- Governmental and regulatory bodies
- Associations





Governance Charter

Recent accomplishments

- Accomplishments of GS1, the user community, and GS1
 Member Organisations since the GS1 Healthcare Conference
 in Orlando (June 2007)
 - GTIN Allocation Rules for Healthcare approved
 - In the US, the Healthcare Supply Chain Standards Coalition endorses GS1 Standards
 - "To aggressively move the industry toward adoption, the Standards Coalition is actively working with GS1 to enhance its standards to meet healthcare's needs."
 - In Canada, GS1 Canada and CareNET Services Inc. announce strategic alliance



Recent accomplishments (continued)

- In Kenya, GS1 hosts «Afrihealth 2007 Advancing ICT for Patient Safety in Healthcare in Africa» in Nairobi
- In Australia, Australian Public Health eProcurement to use GS1 XML (NEHTA)
- In New Zealand, the Ministry of Health announces Medication Safety Project
- In the UK, 50 NHS hospitals have registered with GS1 UK

- Eucomed recommends the adoption of GS1 standards
- Cooperation with ICCBBA (ISBT)
 - to ensure interoperability of standards
